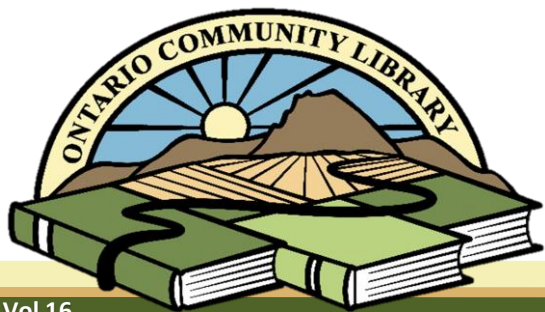

Libby is completely free. It's free to install, and there are no subscription costs, no in-app purchases, and no late fees. Enjoy Libby on almost any device! Download the Libby app on a phone or tablet, access in a web browser (libbyapp.com), listen with Android Auto or Apple CarPlay, transfer to an ereader, and more. All you need is a valid library card from your library and a pin or password to get started. **Call or stop by the library to learn more. 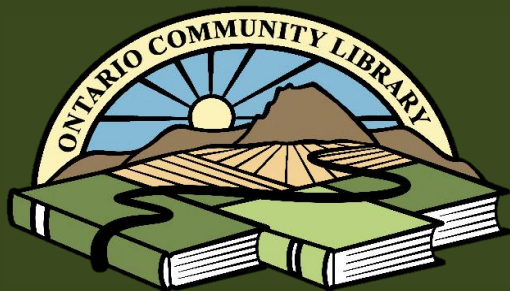
