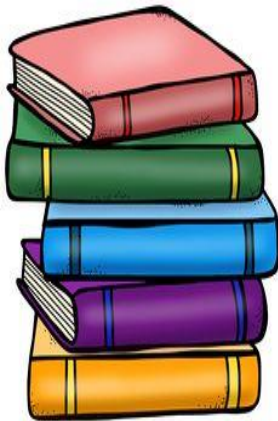
## Library Resource Links

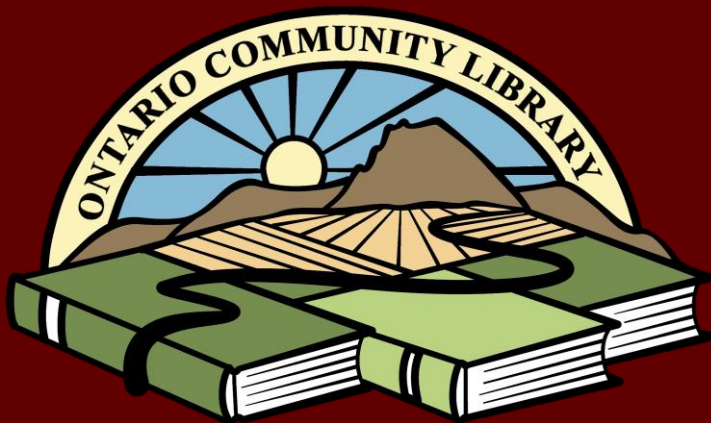
## Free at the Library
